# Why you need to be a member of the Divers Alert Network

For some fortunate divers, March-break is the time to head someplace warm and dive. So this month's column is a push to have those south-bound divers, who are not already members, to join the Divers Alert Network. DAN's story began in the late 70s when the US military began to phase-out a 24 hour emergency hotline that had been used by civilian divers. DAN took over this service and grew from just a hotline, to the world's leader in diving research, dive medicine training and dive insurance. Despite all that DAN offers, membership remains amazingly inexpensive. For the price of what I now pay for gas in a single month (but interestingly used to get for free) you can get all of this:

**24 hour access to dive medicine specialists.** In an emergency, anytime and anywhere in the world, you can call a DAN dive medicine specialist. In fact, the smart move if you do have a dive emergency is to have your emergency physician call a DAN physician before treatment is even started! As a DAN member you can also go online right now and chat about non-urgent medical issues. Although if you are going online just to chat, how sad is <u>your</u> life?

**The best dive travel insurance.** DAN membership provides no BS insurance designed by divers that covers medical and transport costs, hyperbaric chamber treatment, hospital costs, replacement costs for diving equipment, extra accommodation costs, disability payments and more. As a Canadian without insurance, just try to wrap your head around a six-figure medical bill after a dive accident. Diving without insurance is needlessly careless, period. **The Alert Diver magazine.** Published quarterly, Alert Diver is a fantastic magazine with opinion pieces and articles on a wide-range of dive topics. Included in your DAN membership, Not really sure, just take a look at some of these great back issues available online <u>http://www.alertdiver.com</u>.

**DAN collects data on dive incidents and supports dive medicine research.** Sometimes we can learn from the misfortunes of others. Sometimes people are just idiots and nothing can be gained from their disasters. Either way, DAN collects the data and publishes the DAN Annual Diving Report. These reports track data on the causes of dive incidents all over the world. Your membership supports this important service.

DAN does more than just record incidents, DAN also supports independent diving research. The results of this research is used to make dive industry policy on safe practices. Ever wonder who decided how long you have to wait to fly after diving? Yup, that was DAN.


**DAN teaches.** DAN trains instructors, technicians and physicians. Through seminars and courses DAN sets the standard in dive safety, research and education. DAN's mandate has always been about diver safety. Why not take a local DAN first aid or oxygen provider course or travel to some tropical paradise and learn about dive medicine there?



**DAN supports humanitarian work.** By building hyperbaric chambers in poorer countries, DAN increases the safety of local and visiting divers.

**DAN supports exploration.** For example, DAN contributed a research team for the recent efforts to re-open diving at the Bell Island Mines in Newfoundland.

In summary, we often have different reasons to dive but at its core, diving is still about the science of the human body underwater. DAN supports that science and divers in all kinds of rough situations. In my mind, DAN has no trouble living up to its motto "Divers helping divers".
