# **Exercise Roguish Buoy**

Exercise Roguish Buoy is a Canadian Combat Diver Exercise held annually normally in Esquimalt, at least for the last few years. It is an exercise to test the Combat Divers' skills both in planning and executing military operations underwater. The tasks vary from year to year but normally include Underwater Demolitions, Construction, Navigation and general proficiency anywhere from the surface to 100fsw (30msw).



This year, members of 1 CER (Edmonton Alberta), 2 CER (Petawawa Ontario), 4 ESR (Gagetown New Brunswick), 5 RGC (Valcartier Quebec), The Army Dive Center (Gagetown New Brunswick) and Canadian Forces School of Military Engineering (Gagetown New Brunswick) took part in the two week dive training extravaganza. Divers from all across the country worked on tasks and accumulated an extensive amount of bottom time.

They participated in all phases of the training cycle from Diving, Supervising, Boat Operator, Standby Diver and Tender. Some of their tasks included target demolition at Whirl Bay and construction of Scaffolding underwater. These types of tasks also incorporate use of ropes and lifting tasks and are very good at exercising the diver's buoyancy and trim skills.

This year marked a landmark. Master Warrant Officer Gino Sharp was there participating in his 23<sup>rd</sup> consecutive Roguish Buoy. Gino has helped shape Army Diving into what it is today and has trained and supervised many of the divers within the community today. Thank You for your dedication Gino!
