PADI Advanced Open Water - October 10 & 11



On Thanksgiving weekend we will be at Atlas Park for the last Advanced Open Water Diver course for the year! We recommend early registration as spots will be limited. Cost is \$300+HST and includes the online learning! Equipment rentals for students are discounted 25%. We will start Saturday at 11am and complete 3 dives including Peak Performance Buoyancy, Navigation and a Night dive. On Sunday we will do the Deep dive, and then "divers choice" from a selection for the last dive.

PADI Rescue Diver - October 17 & 18



Students have the opportunity to round out their training for the year with the Rescue Diver course. Learn to prevent and manage problems in the water, and become more confident in your skills as a diver! It's a challenging, yet very rewarding course. Cost is \$300+HST and includes the online learning! Equipment rentals for students are discounted 25%. We will start Saturday at 11am and complete a series of dives and scenarios over 2 days.






Events in September
